






#### <u>Meals & Prayers for Priests</u>

## A moment with Father Anh Tuan Phan

With his humble and quiet demeanor, you understand immediately that Fr. Phan has an uncommon amount of depth and humility to offer. Admittedly, he is an introvert. But we sat down for the follow-up to our first interview and were able to get to know him a little better. Here is what we learned...



#### What about being a Priest brings you the most joy?

Fr. Phan: All the sacraments, especially anointing of the sick and reconciliation. They bring me such great joy. I think, who am I, you know? We are such unworthy earthly vessels but through God's great mercy he allows us to be instruments of his peace and healing. I really love being able to bring God's comfort to people when they are sick or need it most. That is an honor.

#### When did you know you were called to be a priest?

Fr. Phan: It was gradual revelation but my grandmother said one day, "Why don't you become a priest?" And that opened in my heart an invitation. She said, "Just take the exam for seminary and if you pass then that will be a sign. If you don't pass, then go have a family." But I passed. He smiles shyly.


#### What book or movie has impacted you?

I love Venerable Fulton Sheen. He is so incredibly wise and inspirational. I read all his books and download all his old shows "Life is Worth Living" on podcasts. We can learn a lot from him.

## What did Sheen teach in particular that has made the greatest daily impact on your priesthood?

He never compromised. He didn't shy away or water down the hard topics. People were so attracted to him because he told the truth but he told it with love. He was interested in souls not interested in pleasing people. They could feel his genuine love for them and because of that he converted many souls. You can love people and you can also tell people the truth but truth without love will not be received and if love doesn't have the truth behind it, it doesn't go anywhere.
