

<u>Cathedral Nursery Coordinators</u>

The Cathedral of the Incarnation in Nashville seeks two nursery caretakers for children during Sunday Masses. A love for children and a desire to serve are essential requirements of this role. These positions are part time, non-exempt hourly employees, reporting to the Director of Religious Education.

To be successful in this capacity, each nursery coordinator will need to be present prior to, during, and after each of the Sunday morning Masses that the Cathedral nursery is open. Coordinators will be responsible for recruitment and supervision of volunteers and parent volunteers. They will also keep registration and attendance records, provide age-appropriate supervision, and maintain the nursery inventory and facilities. Good communication skills will be used to promote the program through parish communications. Candidates must be able to meet Diocesan Safe Environment requirements, including a criminal background check.




