



THE CATHEDRAL OF THE INCARNATION IS PARTNERING WITH HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

and four sister parishes to build a home for a family in need. Habitat for Humanity is a Christian ministry founded on the conviction that every man, woman and child should have a simple, decent place to live in dignity and safety. Habitat relies on the faithful in our community to put faith and love into action and to give without seeking profit or interest in return.

How Habitat Works

The only thing that Habitat gives away is opportunity. Everything else is earned. Habitat partners with families who can afford monthly mortgage payments but would not qualify for a market-rate loan. Homes are made affordable through volunteer labor and funding provided by local businesses, churches and individuals. Future homeowners are required to put in 100 hours of "sweat equity" building their own homes and the homes of others. Habitat is both the builder and the bank, selling houses to partner families through zero-interest mortgages. Mortgage payments are "recycled" to build more homes in our community.



The CATHEDRAL BLOOD DRIVE is this Sunday, October 16th, in the FLEMING CENTER from 9:15-1:15pm. We work by scheduled appointments but we welcome and encourage walk ins.

As Hurricane Ian continues to impact the Southeast, the American Red Cross urges donors of all blood types-especially type O donors-to give blood or platelets now to stop potential disruptions to patient care.

Over the last several days, dangerous weather conditions and floodwaters have cancelled dozens of blood drives with approximately 1,000 blood and platelet donations going uncollected.

In the coming week, the Red Cross expects additional blood drive cancellations in the Southeast and fewer donors to come out to donate at drives in and around affected areas due to poor weather conditions. It is important to remember that blood perishable and cannot be stockpiled. With the short shelf life of just 42 days for blood and 5 days for platelets, the supply must be continuously replenished.

There is and will continue to be a
