

THE CATHEDRAL OF THE INCARNATION IS PARTNERING WITH HABITAT FOR HUMANITY and four sister parishes to build a home for a family in need. Habitat for Humanity is a Christian ministry founded on the conviction that

every man, woman and child should have a simple, decent place to live in dignity and safety. Habitat relies on the faithful in our community to put faith and love into action and to give without seeking profit or interest in retur

The only thing that Habitat gives away is opportunity.
Everything else is earned. Habitat partners with
families who can afford monthly mortgage payments
but would not qualify for a market-rate loan. Homes are
made affordable through volunteer labor and funding
provided by local businesses, churches and individuals.
Future homeowners are required to put in 100 hours of
"sweat equity" building their own homes and the homes
of others. Habitat is both the builder and the bank,
selling houses to partner families through zero-interest
mortgages. Mortgage payments are "recycled" to build
more homes in our community.




