The meeting will be held in St. Albert Hall (room to be determined - stay tuned) at 10am on Sunday, January 22nd.




The Cathedral of the Incarnation is the third Cathedral in the Diocese of Nashville.

The first Cathedral was built in 1837 by Bishop Richard Pius Miles, O.P., first Bishop of Nashville, on the slopes of Campbell's Knob in Nashville. Two years later, after refurbishing the building, Bishop Miles named the small church Holy Rosary.

Spurred by the purchase of Campbell's Knob at the site of the Tennessee State Capital and the changing land use pattern with the coming of the railroad, Bishop Miles selected a nearby site for the second cathedral – Saint Mary of the Seven Sorrows, which was completed in 1847.

The fifth Bishop of Nashville, Bishop Thomas Sebastian Byrne, envisioned a new and larger Cathedral to the west of the center of the city. He acquired property near Vanderbilt University in 1902 with the intention of constructing a new building which would serve as the third Cathedral of the Diocese. Work began in 1907 on the episcopal residence which was finished in the next year. With the completion of the rectory, Bishop Byrne then built the Cathedral school and Pro-Cathedral until the church building could be completed. With completion of the Pro-Cathedral in 1909 the Cathedral Parish was established at its location in the 2000 block of West End Avenue.

It was in 1910 that the foundations for the Cathedral of the Incarnation were set into the ground. First to rise above those foundation stones was the bell tower. Next came the building itself. The entire building was completed and dedicated on July 26, 1914 with a solemn and majestic celebration. Since that date, our Cathedral has served the Bishops and people of the Catholic Church in Tennessee with dignity and grace. The church was renovated in 1937 by Bishop Adrienne, and again in 1987 by Bishop Niedergeses. Both times the work of renewal was in anticipation of the anniversary of the Diocese of Nashville.




