

New Pipe Organ Update

The delivery and installation of our new pipe organ has been delayed, in part due to ongoing supply chain issues. Originally scheduled to begin in February and be completed before Easter, the next block of time that could be fit into the cathedral schedule begins the last week of June, and the organ should be complete in early August. The use of portions of the organ will begin shortly after that, but the complete instrument will not be played until after it is inaugurated at some point in the Fall.




When Bishop Byrne purchased the property for the Cathedral it was so far away from the center of town it was jokingly called "The Bishop's Farm." The purchase price was \$14,814. Funds were short and in order to help raise money, the Bishop spent his evenings doing translations from Italian piece works. The Catholic community raised money with donations from 291 persons. Those donations raised were from \$1 to \$1000 with the favorite being \$25.

During the years between the purchase of the land and construction, Bishop Byrne made an intensive study of Roman architecture. Each of the three structures was copied from a building that the Bishop considered to be classic in its own right. An architect from Rome was hired but plans were revised by Bishop Byrne.

The first building on the property was the rectory on the corner of West End Avenue and 20th Avenue. The rectory was completed in less than a year. Bishop Byrne moved into the rectory in March 1908. His reason for building the rectory first was so that he could be on site to oversee the construction of the three buildings he had planned.

The rectory was referred to as a handsome three-story building modeled after the Farnese Palace, one of the most beautiful in Rome. At that time, Bishop Byrne was known as the "building bishop" and the Cathedral buildings were his most outstanding accomplishments.

Monsignor Albert Seiner was appointed the first pastor of the Cathedral and resided in the rectory from 1936 until his retirement in 1971. When Monsignor moved into the rectory, it was evident that it was in dire need of repair and refurbishing. This began a seven year project of repairing, replacing, cleaning and painting. Wiring was updated to bring it to metro fire codes. The beautiful soft pine and birch floors were refinished. Beautiful pieces of furniture were brought down from the attic to be repaired and reupholstered and used throughout the house. Some of these pieces remain there today.


