Through the years, the cathedral rectory has served as the home for four of the 10 bishops of the Diocese of Nashville: Bishop Thomas Byrne, Bishop Alphonse Smith, Bishop James Niedergeses and Bishop Edward Kmiec.

Many priests have lived at the Cathedral rectory but only a few were actually assigned for any length of time. One prominent resident of the cathedral was Fr. Samuel Stritch, who was secretary to Bishop Byrne, Superintendent of Schools and Chancellor of the Diocese. He later became Cardinal Stritch of Chicago. Newly ordained priests were often assigned for a brief period of time to the Cathedral. Some of the priests who resided in the rectory were teaching at Fr. Ryan, which at the time was on Elliston Place. Others had duties at Saint Thomas Hospital or were doing graduate work at Vanderbilt University. Fr. Dan Jamros, who stays with us every July, resided here when he was at Vanderbilt in 1978.

There is a chapel on the third floor that was built as a private chapel for Bishop Byrne. It was used for private Mass but the Blessed Sacrament was not kept there. The first altar was a gift from Mr. Martin Condon, President of the American Snuff Company. They were paintings on the ceiling and walls that were donated by the Collier brothers of the popular Collier Magazine. The artwork was left intact when the chapel was renovated under Monsignor Leo Siener.

The chapel was again renovated when Bishop Kmiec came as the 10th Bishop of Nashville. At that time, plaster repair, repainting, re-carpeting and new lighting were all necessary. The altar chair held special meaning to Bishop Kmiec as it was used during his installation as Bishop of Nashville in December, 1992. More recently, the chapel was used for live streaming during the early months of Covid.

When Bishop Niedergeses came as a young priest in 1944, his bed was in the chapel - unusual bedroom!

During Monsignor Siener's time, there were no phones in the priest bedrooms, just one on a table in the hallway. They left their doors open all night so they could hear the phone ring. Father Pat Connor once asked if he could have a phone in his room. The answer was, "No, if you want one, all of the priests will want one!"

Early in his priesthood when Fr. Fleming was here, there was no air-conditioning. Unfortunately behind the rectory where the parking lot is today, there was a tap dance school. Hour after hour, day after day, night after night until 10:00 PM, the same tune played over and over and over, along with the sound of clicking and clacking of taps. It was quite a nightmare.

There are now several guest rooms on the third floor. The elevator was installed in 1967 after Monsignor Allbert Siener's leg was amputated. When Fr. Fleming was first assigned at the Cathedral in June, 1958, there was no elevator. He often told about having to carry his trunk up three flights of stairs.

Next edition, you will hear why Fr. Eric is glad he wasn't the pastor in the 1960s!


