



Mark Spalding has granted to the *faithful* of the Diocese of Nashville, as well as to *any visitors* or *travelers* who may be physically present in the diocese, a dispensation from the obligation of abstinence from meat on March 17, 2023.

Those taking advantage of the dispensation, however, are exhorted to undertake a work of charity, an exercise of piety, or an act of comparable penance on some other occasion during the Third Week of Lent.

When the rectory was built it was furnished with some of the most beautiful furnishings of the time. Even now there are beautiful oriental rugs, antique furniture, chandeliers and china in use and on display throughout the rectory. The beautiful dining room set was purchased in the 1930s before the arrival of Bishop Adrian.

In an earlier article, you read that Bishop Byrne spent much of his time translating from Italian piece works to help with some of the expenses. There was a long table that he used to lay out his books for translating and also to take care of the many documents and business matters he was responsible for as Bishop. The table was used for meetings of the Diocesan Consulters and conferences with priests. The table was later in the parlor near the dining room. The bodies of Bishop Byrne and Bishop Smith were placed on this table, at the time of their deaths. Black funeral candlesticks, three on each side, were arranged around the table. The body lay in repose so the faithful could pay their respects. Bishop Smith's body lay in repose from Monday evening until 3:00 PM Wednesday. During those three days, 200 boys from Fr. Ryan High School, four at a time, formed an honor guard for the deceased Bishop. The Bishop was attired in his full episcopal regalia and his Mass vestments. He was placed in a casket and moved to the church on the day of the funeral mass. That table is now in the conference room in the Fleming Center.

'Net Surplus" results for YTD 2023 may be overstated at times due to timing in receipt and payment of certain invoices as average monthly expenses are flatline budgeted at ~\$165,000, along with unbudgeted first year receipts from Diocesan Faith, Hope, and Love Legacy Campaign (\$89,831.00) which were received in 9/2022 which are included in the "Business Maintenance & Repair Receipts" (BMAR) line item. The parish share of Diocesan FHL Legacy Campaign funds have been allocated to the BMAR Fund to assist in building cash reserves for future maintenance and repairs expense estimated at \$300,000 annually.
