

Mulier Care is a non-profit, pro-life, ministry based in Nashville, Tennessee, which helps women who have a minimal support network. They assist women with crisis and unplanned pregnancies in their initial decision to make an informed choice for themselves and their children. They help them become better prepared to care for themselves and their children, both before and after they give birth.

Mulier Care focuses on providing women with the basic education, advocacy, and help they require during their greatest time of need. Providing a continuum of care program is essential to helping a woman thrive during her crisis. If the mother cannot thrive, her unborn child will not survive.

The Knights of Columbus believe in this mission and are partnering with Mulier Care to host the baby bottle campaign in our parish. Baby bottles can be returned this weekend. THE SCRUTINIES

THE THIRD, FOURTH &
FIFTH SUNDAYS OF LENT

ON THE THIRD, FOURTH & FIFTH SUNDAYS OF LENT, OUR ELECT WILL BE PARTICIPATING IN A RITUAL KNOWN AS "THE SCRUTINIES." AFTER THE HOMILY, THE ELECT COME FORWARD WITH THEIR GODPARENTS & STAND BEFORE THE ASSEMBLY & IN FRONT OF THE CELEBRANT.

THE RITUAL ITSELF CONSISTS OF A SERIES OF PRAYERS OVER THE ELECT & PRAYERS BY THE ELECT THEMSELVES. THE ELECT PARTICIPATE IN THE SCRUTINIES "TO UNCOVER, THEN HEAL ALL THAT IS WEAK, DEFECTIVE, OR SINFUL" IN THEIR HEARTS & TO "STRENGTHEN ALL THAT IS UPRIGHT, STRONG, & GOOD." THE LENTEN JOURNEY OF THE ELECT IS THEIR FINAL PREPARATION BEFORE RECEIVING THE EASTER SACRAMENTS. "THESE RITES, THEREFORE, SHOULD COMPLETE THE CONVERSION OF THE ELECT & DEEPEN THEIR RESOLVE TO HOLD FAST TO CHRIST & TO CARRY OUT THEIR DECISION TO LOVE GOD ABOVE ALL."



You are invited to stand and peacefully pray during a 40-day vigil in the public right-of-way outside Planned Parenthood (412 Dr. D.B. Todd Jr. Blvd, Nashville, TN 37203).

The Cathedral will be sponsoring Saturday, March 25th, so kindly sign up for that day. Planned Parenthood is still doing abortion referrals and chemical abortions are still occurring in our state through the use of the pill RU-486 (mifepristone).


The Nashville Diocesan Council of Catholic Women


