



Do we really have bones from dead people in our church? Is this part of a horror story? Are we crazy Catholics like everyone is always saying?

It is true that there are bones in the church. Every consecrated Catholic altar contains relics of saints. This is an ancient tradition from the early days of the church. When it was illegal to have Mass, the members of the church would meet in the underground catacombs to celebrate Mass. They would use the large stone slabs covering the tombs of martyrs as the altar and would show reverence to the saints who died for Christ while they focused on Jesus Christ and His sacrifice on Calvary during Mass. Eventually, Christianity became legal and the underground churches moved above ground. The tradition of honoring the saints stayed and relics of the saints were transferred to the altar. This is a reminder that in celebrating Mass, we celebrate with the saints and angels in Heaven. Not only was this a tradition but it is also in keeping with Revelation 6:9, "When he broke open the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar the souls of those who had been slaughtered because of the witness they bore to the Word of God." This tradition does not take away our focus on Jesus but is to remind us to imitate His example and to be heroic and strong in our faith. The Second Council of Nicea in 787 A.D. considered this tradition important and decreed that all churches were to have altars containing relics of saints.


