





Last week we began exploring the contents of the new reliquary display cabinets in the reconciliation room, focusing on the reliquaries in the cabinet on the right side of the window. This week we will explore the cabinet on the left side of the window, which contains relics of St. Bernardine of Siena (right) and St. Victoriae Maurus (left).

St. Bernardine of Siena was also referred to as the "Apostle of Italy" because of his efforts to revive the country's Catholicism during the 15th century. He journeyed by foot all over Italy and preached directly to the public. He drew large crowds with his captivating style attracting many to hear his sermons which often would last 3 to 4 hours. He usually stayed 3 to 4 days in an area and then moved to the next town. In Siena, he preached for 50 consecutive days about the excess of luxury and immodest apparel. He had to increase his missionary travels when he was appointed Vicar-General of the Observant branch of the Franciscans in Italy. His support and work built this order from 130


friars to 4000 shortly before his death. He sent missionaries to different parts of Asia and through his efforts, many different schismatic nations attended the Council of Florence.

Victor Maurus was also known as Victor of Milan and Victor the Moor. He was a soldier in the Roman Army and served the Roman Emperor Maximianus. Victor destroyed a pagan altar to a Roman god and Maximianus ordered his imprisonment. When he would not deny Christ, Victor was tortured for six days. He was not given any bread or water and was beaten. He was stretched on the rack and Maximianus attempted to bribe him with food, property, silver, and a promotion. When Victor refused, he was jailed and beaten with clubs. Once again, he was put on the rack and stretched. When this didn't work, the emperor had melted lead poured over Victor's body and he was beaten. He was beheaded and was left on the ground to be eaten by wild animals. Six days later, soldiers were sent to check on his body and found it untouched. Bishop Maternus of Milan requested permission to bury the body. When he approached it, there were two beasts guarding it, one at the feet and one at the head. The Bishop approached and the beasts withdrew so the corpse could be wrapped and buried.


#### Camp St. Cecilia - Broadway Baby
