<p><small>**"Net Surplus" results may be overstated at times due to the timing of receipt and payment of certain invoices as average monthly expenses were flat-line budgeted at ~\$165,000 for FY 2023. Additionally, unbudgeted first year receipts from the Diocesan Faith, Hope, and Love Legacy Campaign (\$89,831.00) that were received in 9/2022 are included in the "Business Maintenance & Repair Receipts" (BMAR) line item. The parish share of Diocesan FHL Legacy Campaign funds have been allocated to the BMAR Fund to assist in building cash reserves for future maintenance and repairs expense of parish facilities estimated at \$300,000 annually. Other Operating Revenues inflated in FY 2022 by one-time events totaling \$228,717 (Insurance Casualty Loss Recovery- \$115,602 and SBA PPP Loan Forgiveness- \$113,115).</small></p>

The Assumption of Mary on Tuesday, August 15th is a Holy Day of Obligation.

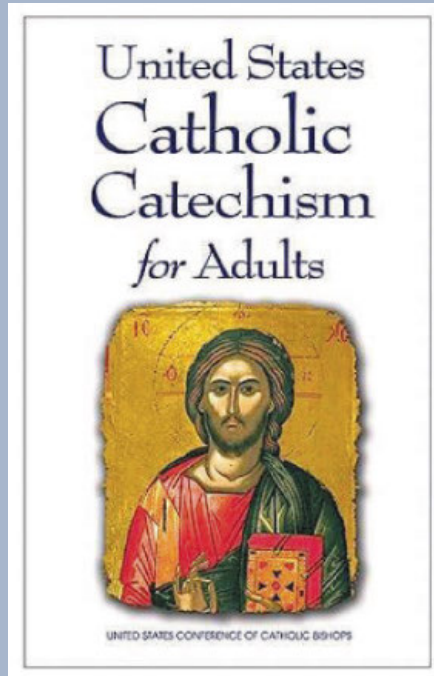

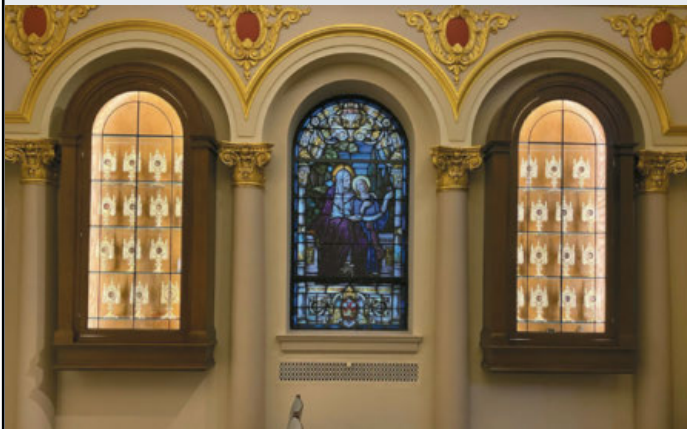

Check Out Our New Reliquaries!

You should visit the new reliquaries in the Confessional Chapel! Relics are physical objects that have a direct association with the saints or with Our Lord. They are usually broken down into three classes. First class relics are the body or fragments of the body of a saint, such as pieces of bone or flesh. Second class relics are something that a saint personally owned, such as a shirt or book (or fragments of those items). Third class relics are those items that a saint touched or that have been touched to a first, second, or another third class relic of a saint. We're fortunate to have so many first class relics!

WHAT IS IT AND WHY NOW?

BECAUSE THE CHURCH NEEDS HEALING, AND THE WORLD NEEDS THE CHURCH

Scandal, division, disease, doubt. The Church has withstood each of these throughout our very human history. But today we confront all of them, all at once. Our response in this moment is pivotal.
