




# **Meals for Priests**

# National Eucharistic Revival WHAT IS IT AND WHY NOW?

#### BECAUSE THE CHURCH NEEDS HEALING, AND THE WORLD NEEDS THE CHURCH

Scandal, division, disease, doubt. The Church has withstood each of these throughout our very human history. But today we confront all of them, all at once. Our response in this moment is pivotal.

In the midst of these roaring waves, Jesus is present, reminding us that he is more powerful than the storm. He desires to heal, renew, and unify the Church and the world.

How will he do it? By uniting us once again around the source and summit of our faith in the celebration of the Eucharist. The National Eucharistic Revival is the joyful, expectant, grassroots response of the entire Catholic Church in the U.S. to this divine invitation.

#### WHAT IT MEANS AT PARISH LEVEL

THE YEAR OF PARISH REVIVAL is June 11, 2023 - Jul 17, 2024

This phase will foster Eucharistic devotion at the parish level, strengthening our liturgical life through faithful celebration of the Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, missions, resources, preaching, and organic movements of the Holy Spirit.

The first disciples were not sent out to change the world on day one! They had to get to know Jesus on a deep, personal level before their mission of evangelization could begin. The first step in this Revival is for each of us to do the same. The closer you are to Jesus, the easier it will be to hear His voice when He needs you to take action!
