## Blood Drive!

The Cathedral will host the third and final Blood Drive for 2023 on Sunday, October 22 in the Fleming Center from 9:15am–1:15pm. Signups are easy and

can be done three ways. For online signups go to www.redcrossblood.org, click on 'account login' at the top right side of the page, and login in as a "donor", enter the sponsor code 'cathedral019' and then schedule your donation appointment time. By phone, call Sally Stack: (615) 400-2932. We will have signups in person in the vestibule after all Masses on October 7/8 and 14/15. If you are 17 (16 with parental consent), weigh at least 110 pounds, and are in good general health you may be eligible to donate. This will be the third and last blood drive we host at Cathedral for 2023. The total units collected year to date is 65 units.

The Red Cross national blood supply has fallen by about 25% since early August as donor turnout dropped on the heels of one of the busiest travel seasons on record, back to school activities and an already active hurricane season. Blood product distributions to hospitals are outpacing the number of blood donations coming in, and the distributions of some of the most needed blood types to hospitals have been reduced in recent weeks. The Red Cross is working with hospitals around the clock to meet to blood needs of patients-but can't do it alone.

**All Saints' Day** is a **Holy Day of Obligation** celebrated by the liturgical Church on Wednesday, November 1st. It celebrates the feast or solemnity of all the saints in Heaven, both recognized by the Church as holy men and women and those who remain unknown. Catholics are expected to attend Mass on this day. All Saints' Day was started by Pope Boniface IV, who consecrated the Pantheon at Rome to the Virgin Mary and all the martyrs on May 13th in 609 AD.

Our Cathedral Mass schedule is as follows: 5:30 pm Vigil Mass on Tuesday, October 31st and 7:00 am, 12:10 pm, and 5:30 pm on Wednesday, November 1st.



The Cathedral of the Incarnation is partnering with Habitat for Humanity and three sister parishes to build a home for a family in need. Habitat for Humanity is a Christian ministry founded on the conviction that every man, woman and child should have a simple, decent place to live in dignity and safety. Habitat relies on the faithful in our community to *put faith and love into action* and to *give without seeking profit or interest in return*.

## Meet Dur Partner Family

LaTasha's lease was not renewed after 4 years. With 30 days to find housing, she and her two toddlers were facing homelessness. She's kept her medical specialist job but pays \$400 more for rent.

## How Habitat Works

The only thing that Habitat gives away is opportunity. Everything else is earned. Habitat partners with families who can afford monthly mortgage payments but would not qualify for a market-rate loan. Homes are made affordable through volunteer labor and funding provided by local businesses, churches and individuals. Future homeowners are required to put in 100 hours of "sweat equity" building their own homes and the homes of others. Habitat is both the builder and the bank, selling houses to partner families through zero-interest mortgages. Mortgage payments are "recycled" to build more homes in our community.


