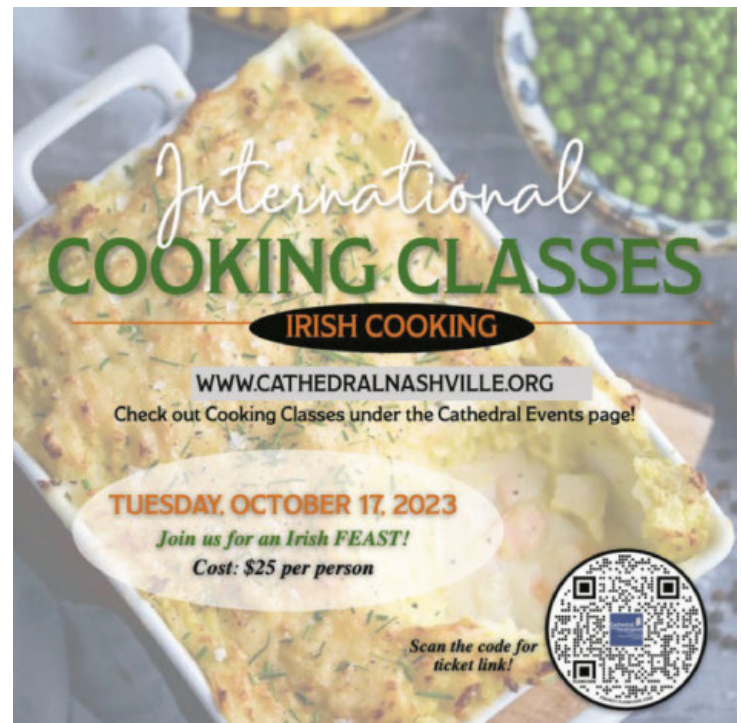

Blood Drive!

The Cathedral will host the third and final Blood Drive for 2023 on Sunday, October 22 in the Fleming Center from 9:15am-1:15pm. Signups are easy and can be done three ways. For online signups go to www.redcrossblood.org, click on 'account login' at the top right side of the page, and login in as a "donor", enter the sponsor code 'cathedral019' and then schedule your donation appointment time. By phone, call Sally Stack: (615) 400-2932. We will have signups in person

in the vestibule after all Masses on October 7/8 and 14/15. If you are 17 (16 with parental consent), weigh at least 110 pounds, and are in good general health you may be eligible to donate. This will be the third and last blood drive we host at Cathedral for 2023. The total units collected year to date is 65 units.

The Red Cross national blood supply has fallen by about 25% since early August as donor turnout dropped on the heels of one of the busiest travel seasons on record, back to school activities and an already active hurricane season. Blood product distributions to hospitals are outpacing the number of blood donations coming in, and the distributions of some of the most needed blood types to hospitals have been reduced in recent weeks. The Red Cross is working with hospitals around the clock to meet the blood needs of patients-but can't do it alone.

The four rectangular sculptures framing the altar are the four Gospel writers. In religious art there are images of the four evangelists using the symbols of an eagle, a lion, an ox, and the face of man. Tradition says that Saint Jerome applied these symbols from the Old Testament book of Ezekiel and the New Testament books of Revelation.

These sculptures in our Cathedral are made of scagliola which is an ornamental plaster consisting of ground gypsum and glue that is colored with marble or granite dust. When polished, scagliola has the appearance, hardness and surface of marble but is much more cost effective than marble. In 1914, these sculptures cost \$600.

Looking at the sanctuary, the picture at the top left is John. John's symbol is the eagle because of the lofty heights he makes in his Gospel, especially the prologue.

The depiction on the lower left is Matthew. His symbol is man. The opening of Matthew's Gospel establishes Jesus as man.

The top right is Mark. His symbol is the lion because he begins his Gospel with the ministry of John the Baptist - "the voice crying out in the desert". The lion is associated with the power and strength of Jesus. Revelation 5:5 describes Jesus as "the lion of the tribe of Judah".

Luke is at the bottom on the right. His symbol is the ox. His Gospel begins with the priestly service of Zechariah and completes with the sacrifice of Jesus.
