



The Holy See has invited the People of God to continue reflecting on the structure and organization of the Church, as it pertains to Her mission in proclaiming and living out the Gospel. The Diocese of Nashville is hosting listening sessions throughout Middle Tennessee. We hope that you can attend one of the synodal sessions.

The Cathedral is hosting a diocesan-wide listening session for the Synod on Synodality. All are welcome to attend and participate.

Our session will be on Wednesday, February 28th from 6:30-7:30 p.m. in the Fleming Center.

40 days of prayer and fasting for an end to abortion. You are invited to stand and peacefully pray during a 40-day vigil in the public right-of-way outside Planned Parenthood (412 Dr. D.B. Todd Jr. Blvd, Nashville, TN 37203), and also to help spread the word about this important community outreach. Please come and pray for at least an hour.

The Cathedral will be sponsoring Saturday March 2nd, so kindly sign up for that day. Planned Parenthood is still doing abortion referrals and chemical abortions are still occurring in our state through the use of the pill RU-486 (mifepristone).



Blood Drive!

The Cathedral will host the first **Blood Drive** for 2024 on Sunday, March 3rd from 9:15-1:15 in the Fleming Center. Sign-ups are very easy and can be done three ways. For online sign ups go to <u>www.redcrossblood.org</u> and click on "account login" at the top right hand side of the page and login as a "donor", enter the sponsor code "cathedral019"

and then schedule your donation appointment time. By phone call Sally Stack at (615) 400-2932. We will have in person sign-ups after all Masses on Feb 17/18 and Feb 24/25 in the Cathedral Narthex. If you are 17 (16 with parental consent), weigh at least 110 pounds and are in good general health, you may be eligible to donate. This is the first of three blood drives the Cathedral with host in 2024.


The American Red Cross continues to experience an emergency blood shortage as severe winter weather has impacted the ability to rebuild the blood supply. Since the beginning of the year, blood drives have been cancelled in nearly every state where the Red Cross collects blood, causing thousands of potential donations to go uncollected.
