



- Vanderbilt Garage access from Terrace Place. Use entrance closest to Cathedral parking lots








Room In The Inn is almost over for the year. We end the last Tuesday of the month,

The Chrism Mass is one of the most solemn and important liturgies of the Christian liturgical calendar. This year the Chrism Mass will be held at the Catholic Pastoral Center on March 26 at 6:30 PM. It is also one of the principal expressions of the fullness of the bishops' priesthood and signifies the closeness of the priests with him. It is a celebration of the priesthood with Jesus' words at the last supper, "do this in memory of me." All present renew their baptismal promises and the priests and deacons renew their promises made at their ordinations.

The Sacred Chrism is the only oil that is consecrated. The others are blessed. The Sacred Chrism is used for baptisms, confirmations, holy orders and consecration of churches and altars.

The Oil of Catechumens is used in the teaching ministry of the church.

The Oil of the Sick (or Infirm) is used in the healing ministry of the church, the Anointing of the Sick.

The Sacred Chrism is a mixture of olive oil and balsam, an aromatic resin. The balsam is poured into the oil which gives it a sweet smell to remind us of the "odor of sanctity" as those who are anointed with it are called to serve. The bishop breathes over the vessel containing the Chrism symbolizing the Holy Spirit coming down to consecrate the oil. This recalls Jesus in John 20:22 when He breathed upon the apostles saying "Receive the Holy Spirit." At the same time, the concelebrating priests extend their hands and silently say the prayer of consecration. The Rite of Reception is when the representatives from every parish receive the oils signifying each parish's unity with their Bishop. Whenever the oils are used, the ministry of the bishop who blessed or consecrated them is symbolically present.

In the Cathedral, our oils are kept in silver urns which are on display in a cabinet called an ambry. Our ambry is located just outside the door entering the sacristy from the sanctuary.


