

Society of St. Vincent de Paul at the Cathedral

The Cathedral parish is evaluating whether to start an SVDP Conference that would aid our area poor and needy, as well as our parishioners that have temporary financial challenges, through our resources and collaboration with other agencies.

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) is the largest lay Catholic charity organization in the world located in 150+ countries, with over 700,000 members actively serving the poor in their local communities. In the US there are approximately 3,700 local Conferences with more than 65,000 active members helping the poor and needy. The purpose of Vincentian spirituality is for the average Catholic in the pew to grow in holiness by personally helping those in need. The main focus of SVDP is not about the poor, but about Catholics. It is about Catholics helping the poor, and growing in holiness by doing so.

There are currently 10 SVDP Conferences in our diocese: St. Christopher (Dickson), Our Lady of the Lake (Hendersonville), St. Henry (Nashville), St. John Vianney (Gallatin), St. Matthew (Franklin), St. Patrick (McEwen), Immaculate Conception (Clarksville), St. Edward (Nashville), Sacred Heart (Lawrenceburg), and St. Ann (Nashville). The 11th Conference at Holy Rosary (Donelson) is in process. Cathedral would be the 12th Conference.

Cursillo **A Spiritual Resurrection Mark Your Calendar!**





Originally the clerestory windows in the nave of the church were made of clear prismatic glass. In 1937 they were replaced with art glass windows of pastel hues. At that time some of the prismatic glass windows were donated to Holy Angels Parish in Dyersburg, now part of the Memphis Diocese. The current windows are made of art glass from Louisville Art Glass Company. They include blue Flashed Glass, hand blown from France, drawn antique lead crystal glass, and a clear glass forming a checkerboard effect. Some glass paint was also used. On sunny days a rainbow effect can be seen throughout the church.

Below the clerestory windows are the large roman letters forming the Angelus Prayer. This is from the announcement

of the Angel Gabriel to Mary found in Luke 1:26-38 denoting the Incarnation, the name of our church. The Angelus is recited each weekday at 12:00, before the 12:10 mass. The words of the prayer begin in the southwest corner of the nave. "Angelus Domini Nunitavit Mariae" (The Angel of the Lord declared to Mary), "Et Concepit De Spiritu Sancto" (and she conceived by the Holy Spirit), "Ecce Ancilla Domini" (Behold the Handmaid of the Lord), "Fiat Mihi Secumdum Verbum Tuum" (Let it be done unto me according to your word) "Et Verbum Caro Factum Est" (and the word was made flesh) "Et Habitavit In Nobis" (and dwelled among us) "Ora, Pro Nobis, Sancta Dei Genitrix" (Pray for us , Holy Mother of God) "Ut Digni Efficiamur Promissionibus Christi" (that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ).

The two words on either side of the arch are "Ave" and Rex" (Hail King) and are not part of the Angelus.




Diaper Fair for Mulier Care
