



Records indicate that the ceiling of the Cathedral was the first of its kind in the United States. It is of ornamental plaster called rigalico and suspended from the roof by metal framework making it flat.

The blue of the ceiling represents the sky. The ceiling is made up of three panels above the north and south ends of the nave. In them are Christian symbols associated with the life of Christ as the Incarnation. Some of them are: the tunic of Jesus; the dice used to cast lots for His clothing; the Chi Rho (monogram for the first two letters of Greek for Christ); and, the Roman standard on a spear with the letters SPQR (Senate and the people of Rome).

The center panel has the sacred monogram INRE (Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews), IHS the first three letters of Jesus in Greek, the crown of thorns with three nails, the Alpha (first letter of the Greek alphabet), The Chi Rho, the eight pointed star associated with the Epiphany, the scourging pillar with a spear and ladder, the tunic and the standard and dice used to cast lots for His clothing.

The southeast end panels near the sanctuary represent His birth and Incarnation. There are the shepherd's crook with cross, the monogram for St. Joseph, a star for the Epiphany and the monogram for Mary (Ave Maria).

These all form a sort of Kingdom in the sky continually proclaiming the story of Jesus.






Parking Information


